My PARENTAL EDUCATION RECORDS DIGITAL RIGHTS While my Child with Special Needs is Under Age 18

Education Records Right #1 Education records must be made available to parents

Schools must provide parents the opportunity to inspect and review the education records of their minor child. **Authority:** The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA); 20 U.S.C. § 1232g; 34 CFR § 99.10 (a).

Education Records Right #2 Copies of IEPs must be provided to a parent

The school must give the parent a copy of the child's IEP at no cost to the parent. **Authority:** 20 U.S.C. 1414(d)(1)(B)(i); 34 CFR 300.322(f)

Education Right #3

Parents have the right to receive electronic (PDF) copies of records

An IEP is an "education record." <u>U.S.C. § 1232g</u>. Education records means "any information recorded in any way, including, but not limited to, hand writing, print, <u>computer media</u>, video or audio tape, film, microfilm, and microfiche." <u>Authority: 34 CFR § 99.3</u>

Sample request for PDF copy of IEP

Dear School Secretary:

I am requesting that you provide me with a PDF copy of my child's IEP that you record and store electronically in your school's computer media. This request is being made pursuant to my rights under 20 U.S.C. § 1232g; 34 CFR § 99.3 and 34 CFR 300.322(f).

I am providing a USB flash drive for you to download your electronic copy of the IEP in PDF format.
